

### "Look, I stand at the door..."

Jesus always meets us at the threshold, waiting for us at the crossing where our plans and God's purposes meet. Along the boundaries between what is and what is promised, between desperation and hope, doubt and trust, the known and the unknown, the way things are, and the new thing God is doing, and between death and new life is where the church encounters Jesus.

The places and moments where Jesus meets us—at thresholds, boundaries, or crossings are called liminal spaces. Liminal spaces are in-between places. They offer a transition between locations or states of being: between what is and what will be. They are passages marked by waiting, longing, and wondering. The ambiguous in-between times are often difficult and we feel disruption and stress. But we also encounter the possibility for deep transformation—if we learn to wait and listen and let it shape us.

The ambiguous nature of liminal spaces is represented by a diversity of symbols. Sometimes the liminal space is represented by the shoreline, where the land and sea meet, where the disciples were called to leave their old life and follow. Sometimes the liminal space is represented by a mountaintop where heaven and earth meet, where Jesus is transfigured and is revealed more fully for who and what he is. Sometimes the liminal space is at a communion table, in a hospital room, an experience of Christian camping, or at an open church door.

Life in the Spirit is full of liminal spaces and moments where Jesus meets us and opens the door to the next new reality he calls us to. The church need only listen for and hear him knocking and trust that Jesus is not just with us but ahead of us, beckoning us along on the journey.

The Presbyterian Church in Canada acknowledges that it meets and worships on the traditional lands of Indigenous peoples and recognizes a long and rich history, which predates the establishment of European colonies. We further acknowledge the territory's significance for the Indigenous peoples who lived, and continue to live, upon it and whose practices and spiritualities are tied to the land. The Presbyterian Church in Canada repudiates concepts used to justify European sovereignty over Indigenous lands and peoples and reaffirms its commitment to healing and reconciliation with Indigenous peoples.










